# QRTP Hard to Place, Residential Treatment Center, and Group Residence, Ages 10–21

### Programs provide:

- Hard-to-place intensive care for youth with units staffed at a 1:3 ratio
- Specialty practice in mental health, sexual problem behaviors, and fire-setting
- Diagnostic services
- Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and dialectical behavioral therapy (DBT)
- Clinical support that can follow for up to a year
- Family Finder on staff to help identify resources for youth and work toward permanency
- Aftercare and transitional services for youth and family

#### Locations:

- Park Place (Northeast), Schenectady, serving OCFS and CSE youth ages 12-21
- Academy Place (Parsons), Albany, serving OCFS and CSE youth ages 10-21

# **QRTP Group Homes, Ages 11–21**

### Programs provide a supportive environment focused on:

- Community integration and independent living skills
- · Achievement of educational and vocational goals
- Appropriate recreational activities
- · Aftercare and transitional services
- Clinical support for up to one year

- Park Place (Northeast), Schenectady, serving OCFS youth
- Academy Place (Parsons), Albany, serving OCFS youth

# QRTP Diagnostic/Stabilization, Ages 4-12

#### Schaffer Children's Program provides:

- · Comprehensive crisis stabilization
- Diagnostic services
- Emergency respite with an emphasis on creating a plan for success for the child and family

· Park Place (Northeast), Schenectady, serving OCFS youth

## Preventive Respite, Ages 10-21

Preventive respite is available for contract to any local county department of social services, and is funded by local county prevention funds. Diagnostic evaluations can also be provided as part of the respite if regested.
